

Beaumont and District Agricultural Society - Abusive Patrons Policy

It is a privilege to use the Beaumont and District Agricultural Society Fairgrounds. In response to observed abuse of this privilege, the Society has now adopted this Abusive Patrons Policy.

The Beaumont and District Agricultural Society reserves the right to sanction at its complete discretion any User who abuses the privilege of using the Fairgrounds.

Failure to comply with the following actions is considered an abusive of the privilege:

1. gain permission to use Fairgrounds;
2. pay fees associated with use of Fairgrounds;
3. hold valid insurance for all animals brought on to the Fairgrounds;
4. control the behaviour of animals brought on to the Fairgrounds;
5. exhibit dangerous or disrespectful behaviours dangerous to self or others; and,
6. any other actions that the Society deems an abuse of the privilege.

The Society will implement the following or other sanctions as it deems appropriate:

1. provide a verbal or written warning to cease an abusive action;
2. place the User's name on a list for consideration of further sanction;
3. fine the User or increase facility fees for that User; and,
4. suspend the User's privilege until further notice.
