## What is Hubie braying about?

- For over 10 years, BADAS has worked towards the development of an Agri-recreation Centre on the BADA Fairgrounds, 1/2 mile west of the S&D Aqua-fit Centre.
- The Centre will have an insulated arena of 100 feet wide by 220 feet long with dirt footing and seating for hundreds of spectators.
- The Centre will also have a 2-storey building with numerous classrooms and activity rooms in 4,500 square feet of usable space.
- These facilities will support community groups and their programming in Beaumont and District.
- The BADAS Board and Membership will review the results of a capital campaign feasibility study by iWonder Collaborations for this \$2 million project.
- Partners to date include BADAS, Leduc County, Town of Beaumont and the Province of Alberta
- Your community group's feedback is vital to the success of the Agri-recreation Centre project!
