



BADAS Breed Battle 2017

Disciplines

Dressage – *1 Horse Per Breed Team*- A list of acceptable movements will be distributed to registered teams before the show. Everyone will line up at the end of the arena. The Judge will call 2-3(depending on # of entries) movements, to be performed as called, one breed at a time. The top 50% of horses for the first set of movements will move on to the next round of 2-3 movements, until there is only 1 horse left!

Jumping - *2 Horses Per Breed Team*- A large number of jumps will be set up of varying height and difficulty. Each jump will have a certain number of points allocated to it. The competitors will be given a set time to gain as many points as possible by completing as many jumps as they can, in whatever order they choose. At the end riders can choose to challenge the Jeopardy fence, a larger and more difficult jump, worth the most individual points. Riders are allowed to attempt this fence, but if it is knocked down or refused, they lose that number of points.

Barrel Race - *2 Horses Per Breed Team*- A traditional barrel race, made different by using a 4 barrel, cloverleaf pattern. The competitors will use a 4 barrel cloverleaf pattern.

Trail - *2 Horses Per Breed Team*- As a mixture of "trail" and "Cowboy Challenge" obstacles, this event will test all of the skills of the horse. The horses will compete in this timed event, to gain as many points, based on obstacle difficulty, in the time allowed. At the end of the time, riders will be allowed to attempt the Jeopardy obstacle for a large amount of points, but if it is not completed successfully, the number of points will be deducted from their score.
