Assumption of Risks

Participation in Beaumont & District Agricultural Society's Rural Roots Fair Marketplace incurs various risks, dangers and hazards, which all participants are required to assume. These relate to your Product, Merchandise, Vehicle, Tent, Table and any other Display Equipment.

The Participant hereby freely accepts and fully assumes all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property or loss resulting therefrom.

Marketplace Schedule for 2017:

Friday, August 25th:

- 1:00 – 7:00 PM – Vendor set up

Saturday, August 26th:

- 8:00 AM – Gates open to the 2017 2nd Annual Rural Roots Fair.
- 9:00 AM – **Meet the Maker Marketplace** OPEN for business.
- 5:00 PM – **Meet the Maker Marketplace** CLOSED for the day.

Sunday, August 27th:

- 9:00 AM – Gates open
- 10:00 AM – **Meet the Maker Marketplace** OPEN for business.
- 4:00 PM – **Meet the Maker Marketplace** CLOSED.
- 4:00 – 6:00 PM – Vendor take down and clean up.

Registration Fee:

The Registration fee for *Meet the Maker Marketplace* is \$20 for one 10'x10' area. There are 2 ways to pay – by cheque or e-Transfer. Cheques can be made out to **Beaumont & District Ag Society, BADAS, or**

The registration fee must be received by BADAS prior to being allocated a Marketplace spot.

Cancellation Policy – For those needing to cancel we will offer a 50% refund ONLY if a replacement Maker can be found. There will be no refunds offered to Makers who cancel after August 20th, 2017.

Security:

Makers are responsible for their property at all times. BADAS and the Rural Roots Fair are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged merchandise. There will be people onsite both Friday and Saturday nights.

Power:

Makers will NOT have access to power.

Display Guidelines & Safety Information

Please carefully read and adhere to the following guidelines and policies:

- All Makers are allocated a 10'x10' spot to set up. A total of 36 spots are available.
- All Makers are required to supply their own canopy or tent, table and linens.
- BADAS and the Rural Roots Fair Committee reserve the right to remove or alter any displays that they deem unsafe and inappropriate.
- All booths must be manned during OPEN hours.
- No Maker or their representative(s) shall damage, change or in any way deface the Marketplace premises.
- BADAS and the Rural Roots Fair Committee will have access at all times to the space occupied by each vendor.
- BADAS and the Rural Roots Fair Committee reserve the right to alter the site plan if necessary, or to have the booth participant reposition the booth if required.
- Unless given permission to the contrary, the Maker agrees to confine their operation within their contracted space only.
- Smoking will NOT be permitted.
- Abusive language and/or behavior will not be tolerated.
